



Outreach Education Subcommittee Minutes

Thursday September 8, 2016 1400-1500

A. bCON Progress

- *Updates:* Maria & Peggy Sue completed Pioneer Dupont and have made great connections with this group. Todd Emmanuel & Deb will be returning to Stewartville Schools to complete training with their entire staff. Todd informs group that the school has purchased 6 bleed control kits and placed around key areas.
 - Targeted or in progress groups: Treasure Island/Red Wing, Cambria/Le Sueur, Seneca/Blue Earth, Tony Downs/St James, Green Plains & 3M/Fairmont. Ted would like to check into having a train the trainer bCON class adjacent to another EMS/ED class he has scheduled at United Hospital District, Blue Earth on October 29th. He and another EMT are already bCON trained. Deb offered to assist if needed. Meghan will check with Mark Griffith about scheduling next SC MN Ambulance Directors meeting adjacent to a train the trainer bCON course. Dr. Klinner suggested evening of Dec 15th at The Lakes in Lake Crystal. She would be available to assist on this date.
- *Process for scheduling class:* We need to track the classes we give to communicate this at STAC level for possible future grants. Sherrie reviewed process for requesting bCON class. Go to www.smrtac.org, click on education tab, complete **Request a course** form and submit, Meghan, Deb & Sherrie will review and suggest area instructors. The requestor will be supplied with a training kit through SC EMS, SE EMS, or Mayo Clinic Trauma Center. Training kits include roster, evaluations, jump drive loaded w/ ppt, wound packs, and tourniquets. At this website you will also find a flier explaining **what is bCON** as well as report to be filled out by instructor after course completed.
- *Powerpoint to all instructors:* If you want personal copy please make request to Meghan and she will supply via dropbox to any SMRTAC bCON instructors otherwise a jump drive will be provided in your educational tool kits
- *Guidelines*
 - Faculty requirements: Lead instructors include all NAEMT PHTLS or TCCC instructors, all other NAEMT instructors who have successfully completed the B-Con course, all military approved TCCC instructors, an EMR, EMT, or Paramedic who has successfully completed the B-Con course, an ATLS, ATCN, TNCC or ATC instructor or provider who has successfully completed the B-Con course

- Instructor-student ratio: 7-8 students per instructor
 - Target audience: All course going forth should be adult learners, those that could do the train the trainer and/or "at risk" populations or businesses
 - Who is eligible for train the trainer: as above
 - Getting the guidelines out to all bCON instructors: Sherrie, Meghan and Deb will continue to work on this and get it out to all bCON instructors
- B. **Trauma Activation Criteria Updates;** Meghan informed the group she is working on trauma activation criteria education to Le Sueur County ambulances per area hospital's request
- C. **Open Forum:** It was suggested for possible education topic at future meeting October or December that it covers ICD 10 coding. Deb & Maria checking into availability of expert speakers. Deb & Sherrie mentioned there will be a survey monkey going out very soon to all SMRTAC members to poll future educational needs/requests.
