A. Reviewed Educational plans for April 21st 1100-1230 Pediatric Education

1. Terri Elsbrnd will be in charge of Pediatric Simulation Skills. She will send email to all instructors requesting if any special equipment is needed for their stations.

5. *Basic Resuscitation:* Denise Klinkner MD/Hunchis RN NP

Primary/Secondary assessment following ATLS principles

- a. Will use simple mannequin vs infant crisis mannequin
 - b. Add infant/peds c-collars and IO simulator to this station. Maria will bring IO simulator and Terri will bring c-collars
 - c. Terri will speak with Dr. Klinkner regarding the format in discussing pediatric chest tube insertion
6. *Non-accidental trauma case studies:* Arne Graff MD will review identification of non-accidental trauma utilizing radiographs and case scenerios.
 - a. Deb will have SMRTAC's projector/laptop setup for Dr. Graff's presentation
 7. *Drugs, pain management and sedation:* Mark Mannenbach MD/Laurie Mc Levis RN
 - a. Terri will discuss with Dr. Mannenbach about additional handouts, tools and the ED dose calculator.
 - b. Laurie Mc Levis has volunteered to assist Dr. Mannenbach
